4- Research experience

Based in Sudan:

Conducted research on by-products utilization for ruminants in the Sudan, where I surveyed types, quantities and nutritive value of the different agricultural by-products and crop residues in the country. I developed feeding systems for goats, sheep and beef based on by-products of sorghum straw, groundnut and cotton. I did some comparative research on feedlot performance of goats and sheep in addition to urea and molasses as protein and energy supplements for feeding ruminants. I also did some research on utilization and feeding value of irrigated forages (alfalfa and clitoria).

I initiated, supervised and co-supervised research work of seven M.Sc. and one Ph.D. Students in the area of animal nutrition.

As a project leader, I initiated and proposed together with my colleagues a project on utilization of agricultural by-products for animal feeding in the Sudan. The project was financed by the Canadian IDRC. Total budget of the project was approximately 225000 Canadian Dollars. The project allowed us to conduct applied research in the area of utilization of agricultural by-products for feeding ruminants in the Sudan, to train post graduate students and to purchase laboratory equipments and chemicals for our lab.

Based in the Sultanate of Oman:

I initaited research work on utilization of date by-products and fish sardines as feeds for ruminants and poultry. I established the animal nutrition lab. at Rumais Livestock Research Station of the Ministry of Agric. and Fisheries. I determined the nutritive value of the different animal feed resources in the Sultanate (Irrigated forages, concentrate feeds, pasture and range and agricultural by-products). I established the animal feed mill at Rumais Livestock Research Station. As a result of my research in the area of by-products for feeding ruminants and poultry I formulated four different rations for: small ruminants, beef, dairy and laying birds. Those rations were based on > 40 % local by-products (by-products of dates, fish and oyster shells) and were 30 % cheaper than commercial concentrate animal

feeds. This work encouraged the private sector to invest in the area of animal feed production utilizing local by-products in the country.
