

Summary of PhD thesis:

The study addressed the marketing of milk in central Sudan. Its objective was assessing the feasibility of developing the livestock sector in the Gezira scheme. Accordingly, it focused first, on estimating demand parameters for the various milk products among the different categories of consumers' groups. Second, it employed a reactive programming model to assess the interregional milk trade within central Sudan by estimating the volumes, prices and delineation of the direction of flow of the milk traded between the different supply and demand points. Finally, the study examined the efficiency of the structure of central Sudan's milk market.
